



A Letter from our President & CEO



We are devoting this issue of our quarterly newsletter to a celebration of 25 years of service by our HomeLight Family Living Program.

Back in 1995, members of our board and other volunteers saw the need for assistance to families experiencing homelessness. There were many shelters available for men but very few options for women with children.

Thanks to that vision to serve this population, HomeLight Family Living was born! We acquired property in the South Bay and began a full-service program to help those in need get back on their feet, find work, obtain services, and move into permanent housing.

To date, we have been able to assist 537 families. Remarkably, we have an 85% success rate amongst our "alumni." It has been a true blessing to see families reunited, children getting an education, men and women with steady jobs, and so many in a place they can call "home."

While we have made an impact on many families, the need is still great. The latest statistics show over 18,000 women experiencing homelessness in LA County, and there are still very few shelter beds available.

Thanks to friends like you we are still able to offer help to families in need during this crisis. Thank you for your faithful support and for making these 25 years so successful for the families we serve.

Lina's story of success provides hope for others experiencing life's challenges.

Lina's Story and Life Changing Help

Lost parents, a difficult upbringing and a series of life's challenges left Lina unprepared to deal with the pressures of life and motherhood. But thanks to a lot of help and Midnight Mission's HomeLight Program, she has built a lasting legacy of hope for her and her children.

Tragically, Lina lost her mother when she was just 4 years old but continued to be raised by her father and grandparents. But when she was 9 her grandparents also died and sadly this led to her entering foster care and becoming a mother herself at only 16 years old.

Later in life, after her marriage ended, she was broken and left home alone with her 4 children and just two suitcases. Her future was seriously in doubt and the pathway to a better life was not clear. Part of Lina's life's experience was that she had not had the needed role models to teach her important life skills.

In time however she was able to start learning the important things she needed by attending therapy classes which were part of the HomeLight's program curriculum. This was what helped get her life back on track.

At HomeLight she learned so much! Like not allowing herself to become a victim of life's unpleasant circumstances. She learned the skills to live life in a positive way and what was especially important was that she learned how to become a better mother to her children.

Thanks to Lina's hard work and help from The Midnight Mission she has built a great life. She has now been at a marketing agency for over 9 years and has even received her bachelors degree!

Lina says that her experiences with HomeLight have had a trickle down effect. The program profoundly changed her as a mother and that has helped provide hope and stability for her children. It has provided them with a real chance to grow up with all they need to be happy, well adjusted adults.

Lina's words say it all "I'm very proud of all my children. They are all successful, contributing members of society."
