was exposed to drugs, alcohol and violent abuse at an early age. At the tender age of six, he saw his dad try to shoot his mother.

He never wanted to be like his dad, but he found himself falling into the same patterns of drinking and being abusive to his own son.

One day, as he was pulling out a stick to whip his son, he broke down and said: "I don't want to be like this." He then grabbed his son and hugged him, saying, "I'm not going to be like that."

That promise brought Floyd to The Midnight Mission looking for a new beginning.

There were many times when Floyd wanted to quit and leave, but the memory of a man on the street who

had asked him for money reminded him of what he didn't want to be. "I remembered a man I had seen, who had asked me for a dollar on the street, and something became clear to me: If you don't stop doing what you are doing, you're going to be just like

that man. They're just going to put dirt over you, and that's it."

Floyd worked hard, passed classes with flying colors, and was able to find a job as a dishwasher. Since then, he has helped eight others gain employment, and his boss is encouraging him to go to culinary school!

"I want to make a change," he says. "I know it won't be easy, and some days will be harder than others. But good is always going to

outdo evil. Evil cannot win."
