



taying at The Midnight Mission was not James's original plan. While working in the kitchen as part of Our work therapy program, he applied for Section 8 housing and found an apartment.

Ready to be on his own, James asked if he could stay at TMM just until he could find another job. Unfortunately, that job never materialized, but James found an incredible mentor here at The Midnight Mission - our Executive Chef, **Richard Ramirez.** 

James and Richard not only worked together for over 13 years, Richard also encouraged James to go to LA Trade-Tech for Culinary Arts. For two years, James worked here at The Midnight Mission from midnight to 6 a.m., then caught a bus to school – sometimes getting his sleep between stops on the bus. He completed the course and became a certified chef.

### James, in turn, has befriended and mentored others.

James's enthusiasm for his work spills over into the people he meets. One little boy started to volunteer here at The Midniaht Mission when he was nine. He and his family and James grew so close over the years that they invited James into their home for Christmas!

The life James leads is one of service to others. He only misses work if he is sick. His co-workers know he is responsible and dependable.

James loves to meet the volunteers who come to help in The Midnight Mission's kitchen. His enthusiasm for what he does spills over into the people he meets.

He is a shining example of what can happen when you put your trust in God and dedicate your life to helping others. With his needs met, he lives a life that is usefully whole, encouraging others to "stay focused, stay connected, and don't let circumstances in life knock you off your feet."
