

Edward first came to The Midnight Mission because he was hungry. He kept coming back because TMM had "the best food in Skid Row," and he could safely sleep in the courtyard at night.



It was a Midnight alumni who encouraged him to take advantage of our Healthy Living Program.

Part of the program was attending 12-step recovery meetings. "These meetings were a turning point for me," Edward says. "For the first time, I wanted to finish a program. I wanted to have a different life."

#### A job that changed the course of his life.

Edward's job at The Midnight changed the course of his life. Assigned as an assistant to our Managing Director, Clancy Ismislund, the minute Edward put on a shirt and tie for his new position, he knew he wanted to become a professional. He would answer phones and read computer books in his spare time.

With the support of his family, Edward pursued his dream of becoming a professional. He enrolled at Antelope Valley College for a degree in network administration, and is currently back in school working on his business administration degree. He carries a 3.0 GPA and has received two scholarships!

Edward aspires to finish his education to show future employers he is a changed man.

He encourages others to continue to learn because it will pave the way for the future.
