WHAT: The Midnight Mission will host Santa's Village at Void Studios, where thousands of homeless and near-homeless children will be able to select toys of their choice and meet Santa Claus. Then, during our dinner service at 4:30 pm at The Midnight Mission, hundreds of homeless individuals and families will be provided with a holiday meal "to go."
